

Local Rules For Submitting Entries For GSCCC Competitions

Printed Images - Limit of three per member

Printed images can be any size up to 16" x 20", preferably mounted. The mounting board should not be larger than 16" x 20". This size limitation on the mounting board differs from the GSCCC rules. Limiting our size to 16 x 20 will allow our club to use smaller shipping containers, which are easier to handle and saves quite a sum on shipping cost.

Each print submitted into competition must be labeled on the back upper left corner in the following manner:

"TITLE"

Your Name

NOLACAM

If print is mounted on black mounting board please use a white label for this information.

As our storage space is very limited, members should make every effort to retrieve their prints not selected by our judges for entry into GSCCC competitions and those returned each month from GSCCC.

Digital Images - Limit of three per member

Digital images should be sized to no larger than 1024 pixels in width or 768 pixels in height.

Images must be in jpeg format, and to be compatible with our digital projector they should be in the sRGB color space.

Before submitting your images to our club's, Projected Images chair person, change their file names as follows: YOUR LAST NAME-title of image.jpg

Note: Use your first initial when there is another member with the same last name. Your name should be all uppercase and title all lower case. It is O.K. to use spaces in the title except between the period and jpg.

Images should be attached to emails and sent to the person listed on the NOLACAM website at <http://nolac.com>. Images must reach the Projected Images chairperson by noon the day prior to the club meeting.

35mm Slide Images Limit of three per member

Members wishing to enter slides into the slide competitions may do so by bringing their slide to the meetings. Slide entries must have a thumb spot (large dot) in the lower left corner, as viewed in the upright position. Titles are required. Print your name anywhere on the mount.

These rules voted on and adopted at meeting on July 10, 2008. Amended on May 14, 2009, to add limit of entries.
